Registration

- Eligible applicants may register on the CMAAA 2.0 portal (cmaaa.assam.gov.in) by filling necessary information such as Full Name, Mobile Number, Email ID, etc
- Registration fee of ₹200 (for General Category) and ₹100 (for SC/ST/OBC) shall be paid online
- On successful registration, online acknowledgement receipt can be downloaded
- Please ensure that the name provided in the registration form matches the name on the relevant supporting documents like the identity proof submitted, bank account etc



Required Documents

- Identity/Address Proof - Aadhaar /Voter Id/ Passport/Driving License
- Proof of Educational Qualification
- PAN Card
- First page of active bank account passbook containing name and other account details
- Employment Exchange Registration Card/Number



Eligibility Criteria

- The applicant should be permanent resident of Assam and residing in Assam
- The applicant must have valid registration in the Employment Exchange
- Age should be above 28 years and below 45 years as on 1st April 2024



Minimum Educational Qualification

- For non-professional course category
 - Class X pass for General castes
 - Studied up to Class X for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC
- For professional course category
 - Applicants possessing 4 years (at least) Degree in the field of Engineering, Medicine, Agriculture, Veterinary & Fishery



Other Qualifications

- The applicant must have skill/ experience/ knowledge to perform income generating activity
- The applicant must have a scheduled commercial bank account, opened before 1st April 2024
- The applicant should not be a defaulter in loan repayment taken from any scheduled commercial bank in the past
- Applicant or any of his/her household member (spouse/sibling) should not be availing the benefits of CMAAA 1.0
